Protective Orders

Due to the Covid 19 Pandemic we have changed our procedures for obtaining a Domestic Violence Protective Order. While we understand that this may be an inconvenience, we are working to limit human to human contact at this time to protect not only Court personnel, but also to protect all Bailey County Citizens. That being said, we will do everything in our power to make sure you are protected and that anyone who commits a family violence offense is prosecuted. Please follow the steps below:

- 1) Someone who is seeking to obtain a Domestic Violence Protective Order needs to go to the Muleshoe Police Department located at 210 E. Ave C and ask for a Protective Order Application.
- 2) Read the Domestic Violence Packet. It has useful information including how to protect yourself and your family.
- 3) Fill out the Protective Order Application

- 4) Once you have completed the Application you may contact the County Judge's office at 806-272-3077. They will set up a time for you to come in and go over the application. They will then instruct you how to proceed from there.
